

## The Pacific Seeds GrowCover Program Terms and Conditions

1. Pacific Seeds Pty Ltd (Pacific Seeds) wishes to conduct the Pacific Seeds GrowCover Program, being the resupply of a specified amount of Pacific Seed product, free of charge, upon the occurrence of Specified Events and in accordance with the following terms and conditions (Program).
2. To be eligible for the Program, the grower must:
  - (a) purchase seed from the Pacific Seeds summer hybrid product range (Original Seed);
  - (b) purchase and plant the Original Seed in the period August 1, 2009 to March 31 2010 (Original Crop);
  - (c) register with Pacific Seeds for the Program;
  - (d) have purchased the Original Seed from a Pacific Seeds Authorised Reseller; and
  - (e) the Authorised Reseller must have purchased the Original Seed from Pacific Seeds during the period August 1 2009 to March 31, 2010.
3. Pacific Seeds will provide 50% of the Pacific Seeds' replacement seed (Replacement Seed), free of charge, in the event that the Original Crop fails (being a failure of the Original Crop, in whole or part, to produce an economic yield so that harvesting of the Original Crop for any purpose will not occur) in the first 30 days after planting due to a Specified Event.
4. A Specified Event means the following events which are outside the grower's reasonable control, being:
  - (a) fire;
  - (b) storm (being damage caused by hail, rain or wind);
  - (c) flood;
5. A grower must lodge a claim for Replacement Seed, on the approved claim form, with Pacific Seeds within 45 days of planting the Original Crop. This claim must be accompanied by proof of purchase of the Original Seed.
6. All claims will be subject to verification by Pacific Seeds prior to any claim being approved.
7. The grower must not graze, spray or replant the affected Original Crop prior to submission of a claim and inspection of the affected area by a Pacific Seeds representative.
8. Pacific Seeds' decision to approve or disallow a claim is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
9. Once Pacific Seeds has approved a claim the grower must purchase and take delivery of any Replacement Seed, to replant the affected Original Crop, within the period August 1 2009 to March 31 2010.

Pacific Seeds will provide 50% of the purchased Replacement Seed free of charge.
10. The decision to replant the affected area and the choice of the Replacement Seed is at the sole discretion of the grower.
11. The supply of Replacement Seed by Pacific Seeds is subject to product availability.
12. This Program is only valid for one claim per grower.
13. All information provided by a registered grower will become the property of Pacific Seeds. The information registered growers provide will be used by Pacific Seeds for marketing purposes.

In the event of other circumstances that can potentially damage your crop such as flood, fire, storm/hail damage, we will replace 50% of seed purchased when the other 50% is purchased by you.

Please note that this cover does not include drought conditions and that damage must be reported to Pacific Seeds within 30 days of planting.

Simply complete and return the attached registration form after purchase. Upon receipt of your registration form your details will be recorded in our GrowCover database.

In the event of a claim being made, please contact your local Pacific Seeds agent or Territory Manager.
