### **AGRONOMIC FEATURES**

EGA Gregory is eligible for receival into the Australian Prime Hard Grade (APH) in Queensland and Northern NSW and Central NSW.

EGA Gregory has similar maturity, straw strength and plant height to Batavia and Strzelecki. EGA Gregory offers effective Adult Plant Resistance (APR) to all current stripe rust pathotypes rated (MR) and has a good level of tolerance to RLN (*P.thornei*) rated (MT). EGA Gregory is rated resistant to moderately resistant (R-MR) to shattering.
