BREEDING Pedigree: Sunbrook/H45

Crusader (LPB03-1073) was bred from a cross made by Dr Lindsay O'Brien in the Solheimar Breeding Program. Since 2002, the variety has been developed and extensively evaluated by the LongReach Plant Breeders technical team led by Dr Bertus Jacobs. The line was first entered into the National Variety Trials in 2006.

AGRONOMIC FEATURES

Crusader is a quick variety with maturity similar to Kennedy and Sunstate in the north and H45 and Ventura in the south. Crusader is extremely well adapted to main and later season sowings in New South Wales and Queensland.

Crusader shows broad adaptation and has performed well in a range of seasons and environments across Northern NSW and Southern Queensland. Crusader has very good straw strength and lodging resistance and is suitable to be grown under irrigation. It produces grain of medium size and low screenings in tight finishing seasons and has excellent milling quality

EPR is payable on all grain production, except on seed retained by the grower for replanting by the grower. The majority of the EPR will be paid by Advanta Seeds to the Breeder (LongReach Plant Breeders) for investment in future wheat breeding programs.
