

Seed Storage and Sample Testing Submission


At the conclusion of planting each season, growers and agricultural retailers may find they have some seed left over which can be kept for use the following season. Unfortunately, ongoing seed quality cannot be guaranteed, however, in order to give it the best chance of maintaining quality, there are a few tips to keep in mind:

- Seed is a living organism. In order to stay this way, it must be looked after;
- Keep out of the weather or being exposed to harsh conditions.
- Sunlight, high temperatures, high humidity and rainfall can reduce seed quality and lead to bags perishing;
- Keep seed away from rodents such as mice. Storing seed with bait is a good idea;
- Regularly monitor and keep insect free;
- Do not fumigate with methyl bromide for insect control as this will dramatically reduce seed germination;
- Do not store seed on the western walls of sheds, near shed roofs (top of pallet racking) or
- Do not store close to doorways and direct sunlight;
- Store in areas which provide access to all sides so pest activity can be easily monitored.

To assist with determining seed quality of any carry over Pacific Seeds brand products, Advanta Seeds offers a free germination testing service to both growers and agricultural retailers. If you have any Pacific Seeds stock you wish to test in preparation for planting, please feel free to use the form and directions on the following page to submit a sample (or samples) for testing. Samples should be sent at least one month before the start of the planting season.

1. Ensure representative samples are taken for each batch of seed you have on hand
2. Use an individual sample bag for samples from each batch number
3. Mark each sample bag with date, grower name, variety name and batch number
4. Complete form above and post with sample/s to address on left
